September 28th: _____ **Display Plan Sheet Due** to Science Teacher--returned to you by at least October 3rd: Look into the future and estimate what you think your project will look like at the Science Fair. You have to change all of the words on the Display Board Sample to reflect specifics of your project.

This week's goal: Start your experimenting, and start your research!

October 12th: _____ **Three Works Cited Citations or Bibliography Worksheet Due** to Science Teacher (to prove that you have started your research, and to make sure you are collecting sufficient information for your Works Cited)--returned to you by at least October 17th.

This week's goal: Start working on your display board!

October 19th _____ **Very Rough First Draft Due** to Language Arts Teacher--returned to you by at least October 25th.

This week's goal: Finish your experimenting and polish your report!

November 2nd: _____ **Final Rough Draft of Report Due** to Language Arts Teacher--returned to you by at least Tuesday, November 8th.

This week's goal: Finish your report and start practicing your presentation,
Finally: Finish your display board and perfect your presentation.
