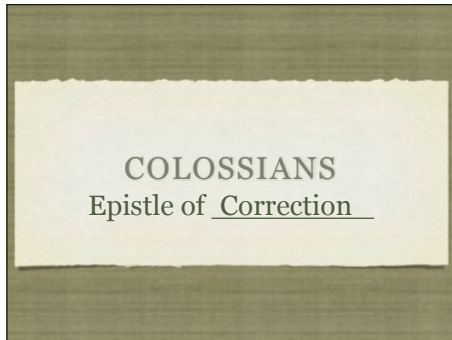
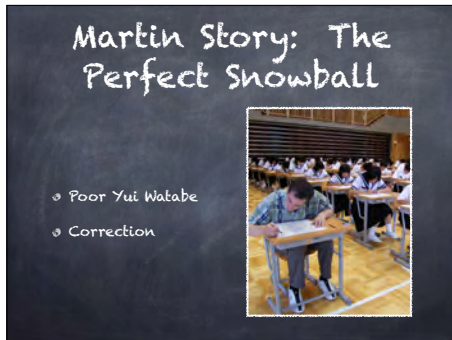

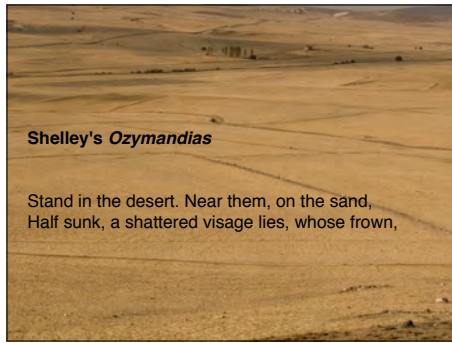

Half sunk, a shattered visage lies, whose frown,

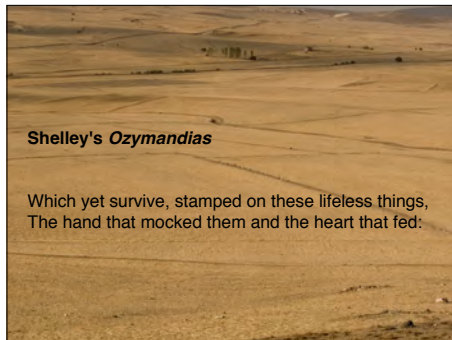

The hand that mocked them and the heart that fed:

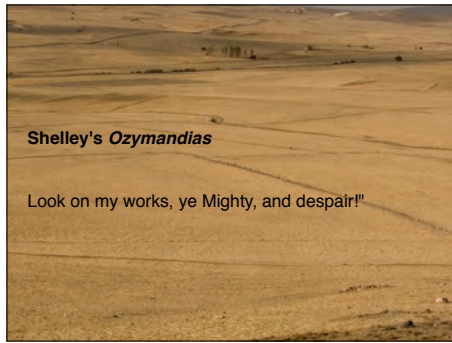

"My name is Ozymandias, king of kings:

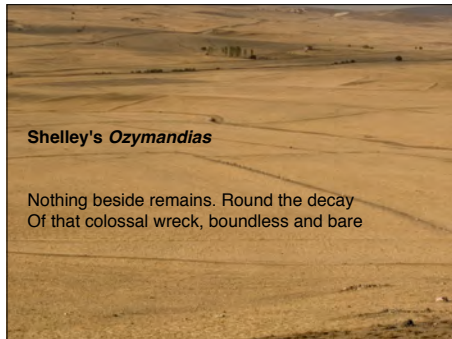

Of that colossal wreck, boundless and bare

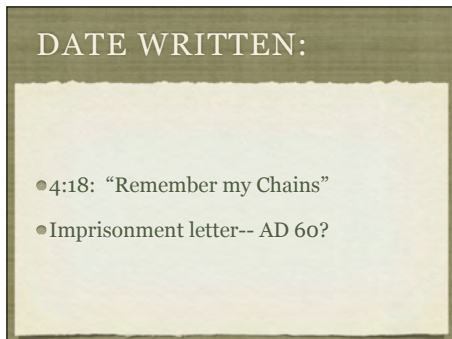
